# Important! Plan to be available Wednesday through Sunday (9:00 p.m.) the week before the Potters Market!

Wednesday and Thursday: all day set up

**Thursday**: stock your shelves and areas.

**Thursday night through Sunday night:** work at the show. You will get a schedule. Take a picture of your schedule with your phone so you will always have it, and/or have a paper copy of your schedule with you.

Plan to bring one or more dishes of food to share in the kitchen.

Suggested items to bring with you each day: small purse to wear, chapstick and hand lotion (building can be very dry), water bottle, phone (turned on), extra price tags printed with departments and your name and \$ but no price, your work schedule and a pen. You can bring a sweater. Wear comfortable shoes!

#### "To Do" Ahead of Time:

Get Baskets for bulk items, jewelry or ornaments. Label baskets with your name.

Order Business cards.

Make price tags.

Sand/clean the bottoms of your items so they are very smooth.

Get **Plate Stands/Plate Racks**- label all with your name. If your item comes with a stand, add that to your price tag, "Price includes stand". If your items do not come with stands, put tags on your stands/racks that say "NOT FOR SALE- This stand belongs to \_\_\_\_\_". Plate stands can be wire, wood, or clear acrylic. They can be purchased online, from craft stores or from the Dollar Tree.

Get **Lights** that can be attached with velcro to the tops of main floor shelves to add light to your items. Bring extra batteries! Remember to remove the lights Sunday night!

Take **photos** of your items for advertising and the Potters Market website.

Make an **inventory list** of your items.

Add your **name** to all of your items and belongings.

Share Potters Market **postcards** with your friends and family. Share **free passes** for Thursday night!

Share Potters Market ads and Face Book posts on your Face Book page!

### **Item Suggestions:**

If items are in a set, tape them together with packaging tape, raffia, etc. Put "Set" on the price tag.

Include items to show what your piece is used for- for example, toothpicks in a toothpick holder, cheap ring on a ring holder, etc.

Label your items, for example, "Ring Holder", "Spoon Rest", "Apple Baker, etc. INCLUDE RECIPES, when possible, if item will be used for cooking/baking. List other uses for items- "dish for soap, rings, business cards".

Consider having a "table seller". Have an item that is easy to make and glaze so you can sell it for a very affordable price. \$25 is an average item that is popular at the market.

## "To Do" List for Mentors

- 1. Call your potter for first personal contact.
- 2. Email them to connect by internet.
- 3. Answer questions regularly.
- 4. Show examples of baskets you use for selling your items at the market.
- 5. Help them price a few items. Explain how you price yours.
- 6. Meet with them at meetings and at the opening set up for the Potters Market.
- 7. Have them shadow you at the set up, if possible.
- 8. Suggest they look at the Potters Market website to see set up, etc.
- 9. Explain the different jobs they will be doing at the Potters Market.
