
PRICE TAGS

All pots will have a price tag affixed in such a way that the customer can easily see it, without picking it up. Sets should have one tag for the price of the set, and each piece in the set should have a tag reading "SET". Pieces in a set should be tied to-gether. Price tags are made as follows:



MUST USE AVERY 8167 LABELS

These tags must be typed outNO EXCEPTIONS. Price will be in even dollars. If the price tags are not neat, cashiering is slowed and mistakes are made. The mistakes cost you money.

M = an item that is displayed on the main floor which includes the large item gallery

B = Items that are displayed in the bulk area which includes mugs and Tiles

We do not designate Jewelry or ornaments on the label. The M and B help the runners return the items from the holding area.

Please use a 20pt Georgia Font.

Make sure you put a dash after the dollar amount. Do not put a decimal with zeros.

It is suggested that Potters should make their own inventory spread-sheet.
